BOILER MODEL IDENTIFICATION

All Dynatherm[™] boiler models are identified by a serial number and usually begin with an alphabetical prefix (Example: FP3421). The following list defines the serial number notations for each model produced since 1937 for which parts are still available.

Series 1945	1937 - 1947	Original two-pass Dynatherm. Serial number without a prefix. • Example: 3421
Series 1945	1947 - 1948	First three-pass Dynatherm, belly flue. Serial number prefixed with 0. • Example: 03421
Series 10	1948 - 1949	Series 10 Dynatherm. Serial number prefixed with 10. • Example: 103421
RB	1950 - 1964	Revised belly type. Serial number prefixed with RB. • Example: RB133421
FP	1965 - 1974	First FP series model. Serial number prefixed with FP. • Example: FP3421
сс	1974 - 1976	CC Model. Serial number prefixed with CC. • Example: CC3421
FPA	1976 - 1977	FPA Model. Serial number prefixed with FPA. • Example: FPA3421
FPB	1977 - 1988	FPB Model. First model using conventional retention head burners. Serial number prefixed with FPB. • Example: FPB3421
FPC	1988 - 1990	Dynatherm FPC. Serial number without a prefix. • Example: 3421
FPC	1991 - 2008	Dynatherm FPC. Serial number prefixed with C. • Example: C3421
FP	2008 - present	Manufactured by Dynatherm [™] . Serial number prefixed with C. • Example: C3421

NOTE: For all ASME boilers, the serial number is prefixed with the last two digits of the year the boiler was manufactured. (*Example: 16CV3421*)
